Secretary of State (SOS) registration

All renewing authorized institutions and applicants for initial authorization are now required to upload the institution's most recently filed Georgia Secretary of State issued Certificate of Authority and Annual Registration under the "Ownership" section of tab 1 of both the Renewal and Initial Authorization applications.

Ownership Reporting

All renewing authorized institutions and applicants for initial authorization are required to report the ownership of the institution under "Owners" of tab 1 of both the Renewal and Initial Authorization applications. An owner is considered an individual or entity with 10% or more ownership. You may add multiple owners.
