Inactivity Policy

Inactive Programs

For unaccredited institutions, GNPEC has defined an inactive program to be an authorized program that has not had any enrolled student for at least two (2) years.

If the institution wishes to seek program approval in the future, a New Program Fee (please see the Schedule of Fees) and New Program Application will be required.

Accredited institutions should notify GNPEC if they have stopped offering any programs so that they may be inactivated in EDvera.

Inactive Authorized Institutions

GNPEC has defined an inactive institution to be any authorized institution that has not enrolled students in any approved program for at least two (2) years. This includes institutions with multiple programs that have had no enrollment in any program for at least two (2) years as well as single program institutions. Such institutions are no longer eligible for GNPEC Authorization. In this situation at the time of Renewal, the institution will be notified of the need to cease operations and surrender student records.

Please note that GNPEC is continuing to reduce flexibility regarding enrollment and inactivity due to Covid-related circumstances reinstating the above policies in place regarding inactivity.

Mandatory Evaluation of Modality Shifts

As of September 1, 2022, all institutions that were still offering programming online but had not been formally approved by GNPEC (approved for on-ground instruction but were temporarily permitted to offer programming online due to Covid-19), must have submitted all such programs for evaluation via a New Program Application(s) and <u>applicable fee(s)</u>.
