Instructions for the GNPEC Student Outcome Data Report

Column A- List the names of the authorized programs as listed in GNPEC's *Directory of Schools*.

Column B- Provide the number of students enrolled between August 1, 2017 and July 31, 2018, the "Reporting Period".

Column C- Provide the number of students who withdrew during the Reporting Period.

Column D- Provide the number of students who are or will continue to be enrolled after July 31, 2018.

Column E- Provide the number of students who graduated during the Reporting Period.

Column F- Provide the number of graduates employed in an occupation for which training at the institution was received. In-field occupation must correlate with jobs provided in #3 of the Description section in program applications (New Program Application or Program Change Application) approved by GNPEC. The reported number should be specific to students who graduated during the Reporting Period.

Column G- Provide the number of graduates employed in an occupation outside of an occupation for which training was received. The reported number should be specific to students who graduated during the Reporting Period, not those still enrolled or who have withdrawn.

Column H- Provide the number of graduates who are not yet employed as of July 31, 2018. The reported number should be specific to students who graduated during the Reporting Period, not those still enrolled or who have withdrawn.

Column I- Provide the number of graduates who were unavailable for response regarding employment status. The reported number should be specific to students who graduated during the Reporting Period.

Column J- Provide the number of students who you believe do not fit in one of the provided columns. A definition of those included in this column must be included in the comments report. The reported number should be specific to students who graduated during the Reporting Period. GNPEC may or may not permit the use of this column, based on the definition provided. Should the definition not be approved by GNPEC, the Regulatory Specialist will require a new definition or require that the number provided in this column be reported in another column.

Reporting Requirements:

Updated information collected from graduates- Once a graduate is employed in an occupation for which training was received (in-field occupation), the number should be recorded in the figure reported in Column F.

If a graduate is initially recorded in any of Columns G- J, he or she can be transferred to Column F if the institution is notified by the student of in-field occupation any time between the graduation and July 31, 2018.
